

Consent to Processing of Personal Data

Pursuant to Federal Law No. 152-Φ 3 dated July 27, 2006 "On Personal Data" (hereinafter referred to as FL No. 152), the User hereby grants and acknowledges to Entrenier Limited Liability Company (OGRN: 1167746833836, address: 2 B. Polyanka St., bld. 2, room I, office 1, 119180, Moscow) (hereinafter referred to as the Management) his/her consent for the processing of his or her personal data (full name, e-mail, phone number, city of residence, links to accounts in social networks, other additional information provided by the user and related to his or her personal data) for the purpose of registering on the website and filling in the Feedback Form and Subscription Form for the purpose of possible future collaboration. This consent shall remain in force indefinitely. In case of illegal use of personal data provided by the User, this consent may be withdrawn upon the User's written request.

The provision of personal data by the User to the Management is considered as express, informed, and conscious consent for the processing of personal data given by the subject of personal data or a legal representative of a minor subject of personal data (the User). Such consent is given by the User voluntarily, by his or her own free will and in his or her own interest.

The person that provided the User's personal data shall be solely liable for its legality and authenticity. The Management undertakes no obligations to verify personal data provided by Users.

The User hereby confirms that he or she has read the provisions of FL No. 152 and the Privacy Policy published on the website. Pursuant to para. 1 and 3 cl. 3 of FL No. 152, **personal data means** any information relating to a directly or indirectly identified or identifiable individual (personal data subject); The processing of personal data means any action or cumulative action performed with personal data with the use of automation facilities or without them, including collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, clarification (update, change), retrieval, use, transfer (distribution, provision, access), impersonation, blocking, deletion, and destruction of personal data. Pursuant to para. 1, part 1 cl. 6 of FL No. 152, personal data is processed upon consent of the subject of personal data.
